The Readings for Sunday May 14th (Year A)

First Reading (Acts 6.1-7) So that the Apostles are not diverted from their basic ministry of prayer and teaching, the Church selects seven men to deal with charitable work. This is the origin of the order of Deacons in the Church's ministry.

Second Reading (1 Peter 2.4-9) Like bricks in a building, Christians are called to be linked together with Our Lord and with one another so that they can serve and worship God as a living community.

The Gospel (John 14.1-12) Jesus has come to prepare a place for his followers in the Kingdom of Heaven. It is by faith that we recognize in Jesus the very actions of God himself.
