Modern slavery is a crime happening across the UK in places like car washes, nail bars, care homes, farms, and even homes, with people of all ages and backgrounds forced to work - or controlled against their will - in Sussex and Surrey.

Spotting the signs

Victims of Modern Slavery may have been threatened, tricked, or made to pay off unfair debts. They might look helpless, unclean, malnourished or afraid and be unwilling or unable to talk, but there are things that you can do.

Getting help and advice
